



Introduction

Thank you for downloading Kompazouk Revolution, all the sounds you need for Kompa and Zouk in a plugin. Kompazouk Revolution is a simple plugin based on many requests : “How do you make this sound ?”, “What layer I should use to get the kompa sound ?”, ...

In this manual, we'll guide you through every Kompazouk Revolution controls.

System Requirements

Windows

Windows 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11
VST3 64-bit

Mac

Intel or M1(Native/Rosetta) processor
Mac OS X 10.7 or later
VST3, AU

Works with Ableton Live, Logic pro X, Cubase, Bitwig Studio, FL Studio, Reaper, Studio One, and many other DAWs that support VST3 or AU.

Installing Kompazouk Revolution

Having downloaded your Kompazouk Revolution zipfile, double click on the zipfile to open it. When opened select “Kompazouk Revolution.AU” or “Kompazouk Revolution.Vst3” and copy it on you Plugin folder.

On Mac :

AU component : (/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components)

VST3 : (/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components)


On Windows :

VST3 : (\Program Files\Common Files\VST3)

or


(\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\VST3)

Launch your DAW, select instrument plugin “Kompazouk Revolution”



A note appears “The sample directory could not be located.” Click on the “Choose Sample Folder“ button. The Sample folder is located in the “Sample archive folder“ in Kompazouk Revolution folder you have downloaded.


If a message appears “Apple could not verify “Kompazouk Revoluton.component“



Go to System Preferences, then Security & Privacy




Unlock the padlock, and click allow




If the message doesn't appear, follow the next steps.

To avoid any difficulties, just create a new dedicated folder for the Kompazouk Revolution Plugin on your Desktop or Documents. So you can put the Sample folder and the plugin folder in one place.


So, after opening Kompazouk Revolution, a note appears “The sample directory could not be located.” Click on the “Choose Sample Folder” button. The Sample folder is located in the “Sample archive folder” in Kompazouk Revolution folder you have downloaded.




Here is the file “Kompazouk Revolution_1_0_4.hr1” Click open




A new note appears “Please select the location where you want to install the samples“. Click “OK“




Open the “Yann Deroi Rogol” folder




Open the “Kompazouk Revolution” folder




Open the “Samples” folder




Then click open.




The “Install Sample Archives” installer appears, verify the folder location. Normally it should be good if well selected before. Double check in case. Click “OK” to install.



A success message appears “All samples were imported successfully. Please relaunch the instrument“. Close the DAW, Relaunch it and voilà.





kompazouk Revolution Controls

Reverb Section

This is a Hall Reverb set by ears, nothing fancy, simple but can run with kompa and zouk style.

Mix : controls the amount of reverb you want

Warmth : controls the airyness or the damp

Size : controls the tale and openness of the reverb

Bypass : puts the reverb off

Delay Section

This is a 1/4 delay set by ears again, really simple but can run with kompa and zouk style.

Mix : controls the amount of delay you want

Bypass : puts the delay off

Master Section

Control the master volume and switch polarity. There is too a width knob, I always hear it in kompa and zouk style.

Gain : controls the master volume of the instrument

Mono/Stereo : controls the width of the sound. Can be more stereo or mono.

Polarity Switch : switch the polarity

Vibes Section

Controls the vibrato

Vibes : Right click to assign a CC modwheel to control it. (Right click, assign midi CC and touch the knob on your physical midi controller).

Preset Section

Choose the sound you want. Click the bank, then category, then the instrument.

Searchbar Section

Search specific sound.

Favorite Section

Click to set to favorite.

FAQs

Q: Is Kompazouk Revolution only made for kompa and zouk ?

A: No, the sounds you need for Kompa and Zouk are integrated in the plugin, they are Tropical sound oriented. So you can use it for Dancehall, tropical pop, Moombathon, and so on.

Q: Can I use it with other VST's, instruments ?

A: Kompazouk Revolution has a large variety of elements so you can write Drums, Bass, Synth, Leads part only with Kompazouk Revolution Plugin. However coupled with other VST's will finetune or add extra flavor to your sound.

Q: What's the difference between Kompa and Zouk sound ?

A: Kompazouk Revolution has both so you can make a complete Kompa production or a complete Zouk production. Up to you to use more of the soft or hitting sounds to your liking and produce a unique production.

Q: Will there be other versions ?

A: Absolutely, this is a version 1, updates will arrive in the future for any issues or bugs.
